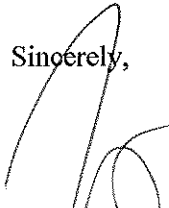
Congratulations on receiving the Veterans Lifetime Achievement Award from the Department of Veterans Affairs and the Board.

I respect your service and sacrifice for our nation and admire your devotion to serving your community.

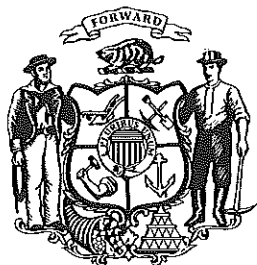
